

Youth Parliament

An orientation programme of 31st KVS National youth parliament was held in Dehradun at Pacific Hotel on 11th and 12th May 2018. 05 Kendriya Vidyalayas of Chandigarh Region comprising one Assistant Commissioner, five Principals and one Incharge teacher from each participating Kendriya Vidyalaya attended the orientation programme.
